Green H Brangus Bull Sale

Highest (Brangus bull): R38 000

Ladysmith – Hylton Green and family held their annual Brangus bull sale on Friday 28 August on the farm Middledale. Buyers from Swaziland, KwaZulu-Natal and the Free State bid on the 42 Red Brangus bulls on offer. Of these, 24 Black Brangus bulls were sold at an average of R17 958, with the highest price being R38 000 for Lot 3, which was bought by Glyn Trodd of Hunters Rest Farm, Bergville. The 13 Red Brangus bulls sold for an average of R16 615, and the highest price was R20 000 each for Lot 33 and Lot 34, bought by Jannie Campher of Harrismith and Dr Hylton Lee of Bergville respectively. The volume buyer was Arthur Ushe of Farview Trust, Excelsior who took four bulls home. The sale was conducted by Vleissentraal KZN with Johann von Wielligh as the auctioneer. – *Staff reporter*

Highest (ram): R65 000

Bloemfontein – The National Dormer sale was held by BKBlouwid, Bloemfontein on 3 September and was a great success. Jan Mostert was the auctioneer.

Many registered buyers attended the auction. The most expensive ram (Lot 210: CN080019) was sold to Scheepers Lamprecht of Amersfoort for R65 000 by Dr Chris Nel of Harrismith.

(Lot 6: AP070164) belonged to Erika Hanekom and was sold for R8 000 to DS Louwrens of Bethal.

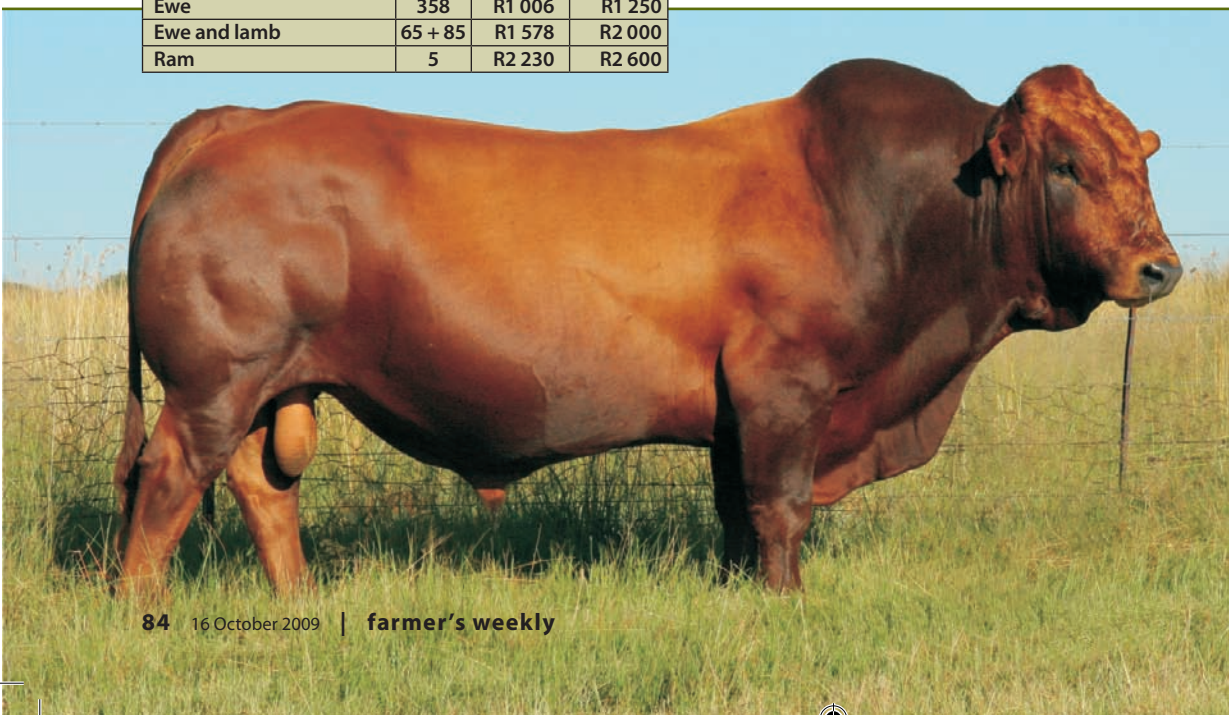
